



CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARD NOMINATION APPLICATION

The Nomination Application must be **RECEIVED** at IPRA no later than **OCTOBER 31, 2006**. Call to confirm if you are e-mailing or mailing your questionnaire.

This IPRA award recognizes individuals who have demonstrated exemplary service and contributions to their community.

- May not receive any compensation (paid or in kind) for their work.
- Must have been associated with the agency for at least three (3) years.
- Elected or appointed Commissioners/IAPD members are not eligible.

The nomination procedures are as follow:

- All nominations must be submitted on 8.5" x 11" white paper.
- Nominations must include the following:
 - a) Name of volunteer.
 - b) Name of the person submitting this candidate for consideration.
 - c) Name of the agency for which the candidate volunteers.
 - d) Description of the nominees prime activities.
 - e) Statement as to why this person is deserving of the Citizen Volunteer of the Year Award.
- Narrative must be single spaced (font size no less than 11 pt.) and limited to one side of a sheet of paper (narratives received exceeding one page will be eliminated).
- You may include a photo if you wish (in addition to the one page nomination).
- Multiple copies will be made from this submission. Any loss of quality due to reproduction is not the responsibility of the IPRA Awards Committee members.
- Selection will be based solely on information provided.
