#### **EVENT RULES**

Each participant must bring their own equipment, which must meet all regulations of the competition. The chairperson of each event will run the event and has the authority to make final calls and decisions.

- Bags: Play best 2 out of 3 games: teams of 2.
- Basketball Free Throw: Twenty-five (25) baskets shot from the free throw line; winners determined by number of baskets made.
- Billiards: 8-ball; best 2 out of 3 games played.
- Bocce: Play best 2 out of 3 games, 11-point games.
- Bowling: No handicap system; ABC rules will govern; three (3) games.
- 9-hole Golf: Peoria handicap system used in the scoring. Tee times start at 7:30 a.m.
- 18-hole Golf: Peoria handicap system used in the scoring. Tee times start at 7:00 a.m.
- Horseshoes: Single elimination tournament. National Horseshoe Pitcher's Association rules apply.
- Pickleball: Play to 11 points. 3 games guaranteed. Women, Men and Mixed.
- Swimming: USS Rules will govern competition; 25-meter pool.
- Table Tennis: Single-elimination singles tournament; players must wear a dark shirt and rubber-soled shoes.
- Tennis: Eight (8) game pro set.
- Track & Field: AAU rules will govern competition; meter distances will be used in the running events.
- Trap & Skeet Shoot: ATA rules will govern competition; 50 targets. Participants shoot trap, skeet, or both 50 rounds per discipline.
- Volleyball: IHSA rules apply.
- Walking: One-mile race; contact must be maintained with ground at all times; the leg on the ground must be straightened at the knee for at least one moment of each stride.



#### **AGE CATEGORIES**

All participants must be 50 years of age or better. Proof of age will be required at event(s) check-in.

#### **AWARDS**

Medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place participants in each age category for men and women. Most awards will be distributed at time of event.

#### **ENTRY FEES**

#### Individual Fee:

- \$26 per person
  - allows a participant to participate in any solo or partner event

#### Team Fees:

- 3v3 Basketball Team: \$180 for a roster of up to 5 players
- Volleyball Team: \$280 for a roster of up to 8 players
- Softball: \$325 for a roster of up to 15 players

Additional Fees: (paid in advance / along with registration)

- 9-hole Golf: \$40
- 18-hole Golf: \$60

Additional Facility Fees: (paid on-site at event location)

- Bowling: \$4 per game
- Trap Shoot: \$6 per round, 2 rounds
- Skeet Shoot: \$6 per round, 2 rounds

Golf Events: The 9-hole outing includes golf and lunch at the clubhouse located at Tam Golf Course on Monday, July 14, 2025. The 18-hole outing includes golf, cart, and lunch at Randall Oaks Golf Course on Thursday, July 24, 2025.

Refund Policy: Cancellations up to 24 hours in advance will receive a full refund. Please allow up to two-weeks for processing. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR NO SHOWS.
